<b>09/01/2025</b>	<p style="text-align: center;">Heard Mr. Manoj Paranjpe, learned counsel for the petitioners as well as Mr. Sangharsh Pandey, learned Government Advocate, appearing for the State/respondent No.1 and perused the impugned FIR and materials available on record.</p>

Learned counsel for the petitioner submitted that the petitioners are elected President and Secretary of Krishna Education Society, registered under the relevant provisions of Chhattisgarh Societies Registrickaran Act, 1973 (hereinafter referred to as 'the Society') and the daughter of respondent No.2, at one point of time, was studying in the School run by the petitioners and she committed suicide and because of the said incident, the respondent No.2 made some complaint against the petitioners' Society. It is further submitted that there was a litigation going on between the Society and the respondent No.2, being a complainant in WPC No. 3843 of 2019, on which an interim order was passed in favour of the petitioners' Society on 23.10.2019 and the private respondent was a caveator in the said case, hence, the present FIR, after several years of the incident which is being complaint of the year 2007, is misuse of process of law.

Issue notice to respondent No.2 on payment of PF as per rules. Notice be made returnable within four

weeks.

List the matter thereafter.

Till the next date of listing or till submission of Police Report under Section 193(3) of the BNSS, if any, before the competent Court, whichever is earlier, the arrest of petitioners, namely, **M.M. Tripathi** and **Pramod Tripathi** in pursuance of the impugned FIR dated 28.12.2024 bearing Crime No. 1386 of 2024, registered at Police Station, Supela, District – Durg (C.G.), shall remain stayed, of course subject to the restraint that the petitioners shall fully cooperate with the investigation and shall appear as and when called upon to assist in the investigation.
